Civil War Signatures At Tonoloway Primitive Baptist Church Tonoloway Primitive Baptist Church will be open to the public Friday and Saturday, Oct. 17 and 18, from 1 p.m. until 5 p.m., during the Fulton Fall Folk Festival.
