**FY 2009-2029 Southern Alleghenies Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP)**

The Southern Alleghenies Planning & Development Commission (SAP&DC) serves as the Rural Planning Organization (RPO) for rural transportation planning and programming for the rural counties of Bedford, Fulton, Huntingdon, and Somerset.

The SAP&DC, in coordination with the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) and the four rural counties, has begun the process of updating the region's Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP). This plan is financially constrained and is a springboard for identifying and recommending projects for inclusion in the state's 12 Year Transportation Program and the Statewide Transportation funds will be spent over a 20 year period. The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) is derived from the Long Range Plan and is a listing of federally funded projects to be completed during the first four-year period of the plan.
